Weston Master Universal Exposure Meter

“The Master 1” 1939/47

The first of the Weston Master 715 series, , this meter was produced at Newark NJ in 1939 and then in the UK by Sangamo Weston in Enfield, Middlesex after the war in 1947. It is the first of the Master series and the first Weston to have an "upright" format. Note that there is a 715a and a 715b - only the dials are slightly different.

- f stop range is 1.5 to 32,
- speeds 100sec to 1/1200
- dial readings are 0.2 to 50 baffle open or 25 to 1600 closed

This meter larger and heavier than the later Weston meters with a dial that is complex to use compared with the dial of the later models.
