Weston Cine Exposure Meter

Model 819 Circa 1939

A Weston 819 cine light exposure meter, dating from 1937, this is really a 650 cine version but it was numbered out of sequence in the 8 range because of its direct reading capability.

Made in Newark New Jersey in 1939

Cine - exactly like a 650 numbered out of series due to direct reading capability as on all future cine models. As with all future cine models, reads in half stops except $6\frac{1}{3}$ stops f stop range is 1.5 to 32,

This meter larger and heavier than the later Weston meters with a dial that is complex to use compared with the dial of the later models.
